M.V.P. College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Nandgaon organized NSS Special Labor Training Camp. It was organized from 10th February 2022 to 16th February 2022. It was decided to adopt a village as per the order of Savitribai Phule Pune University's NSS Department. Accordingly, College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Nandgaon Manikpunj village was selected. Manikpunj village is 15 km from Nandgaon city and named after the famous Manikpunj Dam, this village was used to arrange accommodation for volunteers in the Zilla Parishad School.

This special labor camp was inaugurated on February 10, 2022. Dignitaries from various fields were present on this occasion. Also as the chairman of the program Hon. Mr. Sarjerao (Aba) Patil, Chairman St. spend Committee, Junior College Nandgaon, Inaugural Hon. Mr. Rajeshji Kawade Mayor Municipality Nandgaon. Chief Guest Sarpanch Hon. Smt. Sakhubai Vishnu Mengal and Hon. Mr. Subhash Bhau Kute, Chairman Panchayat Samiti Nandgaon, Chief Guest Deputy Sarpanch Hon. Shrisamadhan Sudam Wagh, Former Sarpanch Shri. Madhukar Darekar, College Principal Dr Sanjay A Marathe, Professors, staff, villagers and volunteers were present.

The dignitaries present on this occasion expressed their thoughts that the labor camp provides an opportunity for personality development and with that strength we can scale big peaks. Principal of the college Dr. Sanjay A Marathe appealed to make Manikpunj village plastic free by working from this camp of NSS.



After the inauguration of the special camp, the volunteers discussed about the activities in the camp. Volunteers were divided into different groups and information was given on the topic of strength of unity.

On February 11, 2022, the entire village was cleaned at 9 am. In order to demonstrate the importance of cleanliness in the village, all the roads, temples, schools, village panchayat offices, all the small lanes of Manikpunj village were swept and cleaned and the garbage was disposed of properly.


And the entire village was made plastic free. This work at 1 p.m. It lasted till 30 o'clock. After that time was given for food and rest till 3 o'clock.






. On two days on 12th and 13th of February, seven divided volunteers created 15 slop pits on the basis of demand of slop pits in the village. Sewage water from many houses was spreading on the streets, so it was equally important to do this work.

Volunteers took special efforts in preparing 4 feet wide and 5 feet deep absorption slop pits in the very rocky Manikpunj soil. Also on February 12, Senior Professor Suresh Narayani gave a lecture on Personality Development. On February 13, Dr. M.B Mankari gave a lecture on Health Awareness.





In the evening tomorrow for soil testing, the children went to Manikpunj village and asked the people to collect the soil from the four corners of their fields. On December 14, near the Manikpunj village temple, volunteers divided into seven groups conducted a soil test for the people of the village.

The amount of nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium from the soil was given to the farmer in the village. Based on the amount in their soil, they are told what their soil is deficient in and what type of fertilizer they should use. The soil test received a lot of response. So the people of the neighboring village came for soil testing. This work lasted till 1.30 pm. Then at 3 pm on February 14, Prof. Bhagwat Chavare lectured on the importance of biodiversity in social terms.





On February 14, all the volunteers of the National Service Scheme prepared 'chari' in the fort area of Manikpunj and cleaned the fort area. On February 15, a street play based on the topics of de-addiction, dowry ban, elimination of superstition, cleanliness, inequality between men and women in the society was presented.

In the afternoon session, senior journalist of Nandgaon Mr. Maruti Jagadhan wasgiven lecture on the topic of elimination of superstitions. Meanwhile, NSS District Coordinator Dr. d. K. Aher NSS and Taluka Coordinator paid a goodwill visit to the camp and expressed their satisfaction towards the work in the camp and wished them well.
